**Sec. 6-204. Definition.**

The term “development matters” as used in this Charter includes: The master plan for social, economic and physical development and conservation; the annual capital agenda and capital budget; any development or renewal project on or affecting public real property or public interests in real property or requiring public assistance; proposed ordinances for the regulation of development or conservation; and proposals for the demolition, disposition or relinquishment of, or encroachment upon, public real property or public interests in real property ;~~and any other items added by ordinance.~~
