ISSUE/PROPOSAL STATEMENT: Allow City Council to elect its leaders/officers (i.e. President and President Pro Tem)

RATIONALE:

ANALYSIS: Under the present charter the President and President Pro Tem are selected based on the candidates who receive the highest and next highest number of at-large votes, respectively. 4-103. In the past, since all members ran at-large all candidates had an equal chance at being selected for the leadership positions. However, with the recent decision to select seven (7) Council members by district and two at-large, assures that the President and President Pro Tem will be selected from candidates running for the two (2) at-large seats.
