ISSUE/PROPOSAL STATEMENT:

Sec. 5-109. Succession to office.

If a vacancy occurs in the office of mayor, the city council president shall succeed to the office until a new mayor is elected. When a new mayor is sworn in, the city council president shall return to his/her office.

RATIONALE: "This language clarifies that the city council president shall return to the position of council president following the swearing-in of an elected mayor, an issue that arose under the previous administration."-City Council Rationale, Letter, dated December 13, 2010.
