ISSUE/PROPOSAL STATEMENT: Remove requirement that the beginning term for members on multi-member bodies, who serve for a fixed term, Multi-Member Bodies begins on February 15.

Sec. 2-110. General provisions for multi-member bodies.

Any multi-member body created by this Charter or under section 7-103 of this Charter may select its officers and adopt rules of procedure. Its meetings shall be public and it shall make a record of its proceedings. The record shall be public. A majority of its members constitutes a quorum.

Deleted: and, if its members serve for fixed terms, each term begins on the fifteenth (15th) day of February

RATIONALE: "The February 15th beginning date for each term, as set forth in the current charter, was removed because, in practice, most boards do not adhere to this date."-*City Council's Rationale, Letter, dated December 13, 2010.*
